Minisha P.M of final year presented a paper entitled "Sentimental Analysis of Twitter Data " in Loyala Institute of Technology on 31st August 2019.

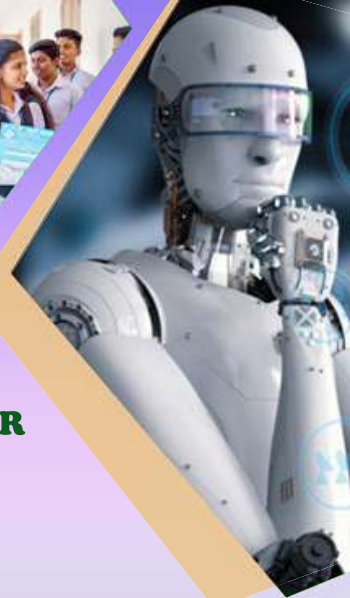
